


Remember the Dugout Pals?

Softball Skills 101

To be able to score more runs, you have to know how to run the bases.

From the Batter's Box:

- Lean forward when leaving the box to help move the body forward
- Run with high knees
- Swing your arms in a straight line, with elbows bent at a 90-degree angle
- Run at full speed through first base, and then turn right after touching the ORANGE safety bag
- Return directly to the base




Leaving the Bases:

- Start in front of the base with one foot on the base and the other out in front
- Push against the base
- Keep your body low to start and gradually rise to your running position
- Explode from the base
- Swing your arms straight ahead, with elbows bent at a 90-degree angle



Shade in the different areas that each player is responsible for.


Left Field	3B	SS

Right Field	1B	Catcher




Ellie can find 6 differences between the pictures below. Can you see them?




